

Notice of Award

Cash Flow Verification Services

At the September 18, 2009, Board Meeting, Florida Housing's Board of Directors accepted the ranking as presented in order of the highest to lowest ranking which are: Causey, Demgen & Moore, Inc., AMTEC and GNP Services, CPA, PA. The Board authorizes Florida Housing to enter into contract negotiations with Causey Demgen & Moore, Inc., contingent upon receipt of evidence that Causey Demgen & Moore, Inc. is qualified to do business in the State of Florida, or, in the alternative, receipt of satisfactory evidence that Causey Demgen & Moore, Inc., is not required to be qualified to do business in the State of Florida in order to render the cash flow verification services as contemplated. If contract negotiations should fail to then enter into contract negotiations with AMTEC and then with GNP Services, CPA, PA.

Please note, any unsuccessful applicant may file a notice of protest and a formal written protest in accordance with Section 120.57(3), Fla. Stat., and Rule Chapter 28-110, F.A.C. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Fla. Stat., et. al. or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Fla. Stat.

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
