Item #1

Section Three, Item A., is hereby deleted in its entirety and is replaced with the following:

A. Respondents will submit their Response to <https://www.floridahousing.org/legal/procurements/RFQ-2020-01-Document-Upload>, and Florida Housing must receive the entire Response on or before 2:00 p.m., Eastern Time, on May 20, 2020, as Responses will be opened at that time. Any Responses received after the deadline will be considered non-responsive. One complete copy of the response in PDF format is preferred, unless specified otherwise in Section Six below, and the file name ought to contain a reference to both the solicitation number (RFQ 2020-01) and the name of the Respondent. Please note that the site will ask for the Respondent's contact information and the solicitation number prior to being able to upload the Response. Florida Housing will not accept a mailed or faxed Response.

Item #2

The first paragraph of Section Six is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

In providing the following information, restate each item and sub-item (with its letter and number), and limit your Response to a maximum of 35 pages in length, including exhibits. Responses to the items must be included immediately after the restated items. Only include exhibits requested in this RFQ.

The three subsequent paragraphs in this section remain the same.

Item #3

The last sentence in Section Six, Item H.1., is hereby amended to replace the date of February 26, 2020 with April 22, 2020. The remainder of this paragraph and subsequent table remain the same.

All other terms and conditions of RFQ 2020-01 remain the same.

To the extent that this Addendum gives rise to a protest, failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.
