

Questions And Answers For RFA 2014-102
Financing To Develop Permanent Supportive Housing For
High Needs/High Cost Individuals Who Are Chronically Homeless

1. Q: We have begun the Site Plan Approval process; but have not completed it yet. The first step in our city is a pre-submission meeting with the city planner who reviews the plans. Would we select option 2 on the Site Plan Approval for Multifamily Developments form in order to achieve Ability to Proceed tie-breaker points?

A: Florida Housing does not make recommendations regarding which option the City should select on the form. The person signing the form should be the one to decide which option should be selected.
