#### 1. \$1,750,000 in Housing Credits will be made available

## 2. Open to Applicants with proposed Developments that:

- a. are located in Small and Medium Counties
- b. have sites with existing Declaration of Trusts (DOT)
- c. qualify for Development Categories of Rehabilitation or Redevelopment

# 3. Set-Aside Requirements

- a. All Applicants with proposed Developments that do not qualify as LDA Developments must Set-Aside at least 20 percent of the total units as ELI Set-Aside units
- b. All Applicants with proposed Developments that qualify as LDA Developments must Set-Aside at least 30 percent of the total units as ELI Set-Aside units
- c. Total Affordability Period of 50 years required

#### 4. Point Items

- a. Optional Construction Features (maximum of 25 points)
  - 1. Optional Green Building/Energy Efficiency **Up to 10 Points** for Applicants choosing to serve the Family demographic. **Up to 5 Points** for Applicants choosing to serve the Elderly Demographic)
  - 2. Optional Accessibility and Universal Design (**Up to 10 Points** for Applicants choosing to serve the Family Demographic. **Up to 15 Points** for Applicants choosing to serve the Elderly Demographic)
  - 3. Other innovative and Best Practices for features that will be included in the proposed Development (**Up to 5 Points**)
- b. Leveraging with non-FHFC Resources (maximum of 35 points)
- c. How Proposed Development Aligns with Local, State and/or Federal Government Initiatives (maximum of 15 points)

### 5. Funding Selection

- a. Group 1 Applications (those with 50 or more points, of a maximum of 75) will be selected first. If funding remains after all Group 1 Applications are funded, Group 2 Applications (those with less than 50 points) may be selected.
- b. County Award Tally As each Application is selected, the county will have 1
  Application applied towards County Award Tally. FHFC will select Group 1
  Applications that meet the Funding test (100% or 85% as applicable) and have the lowest County Award Tally. If funding remains and no Group 1 Applications meet the 85%

funding test, FHFC will select Group 2 Applications that meet the Funding test (100% or 85% as applicable) and have the lowest County Award Tally. County Award Tally's will carry forward from Group 1 to Group 2. Counties that were funded in PHA 2013-07 (Sarasota and Volusia) are considered to have one Application applied towards the County Award Tally.

- c. Sorting Order HC Request per set-aside, Per Unit Construction Funding Preference (Yes/No), Development Category Funding Preference (Yes/No), Job Creation, then lottery.
