Thank you for the opportunity to provide the following comments regarding the Elderly Housing Community Loan. It is understood that developments with existing financing through a HUD program have a preference over any other type development. With the limited amount of funding available (potentially for 3 developments) we respectfully request that staff deem at least 1 RD development worthy of funding under this program. We would therefore request that a goal be put in place to fund 1 RD development and offer the following in support thereof:

- 1. Rural areas have an especially high concentration of elderly people. Young families often migrate to urban centers in search of steady employment and higher incomes, leaving rural areas with a disproportionate percentage of elderly.
- 2. There are a large number of elderly RD developments in need of such funding (including existing housing credit developments), which currently are not eligible and/or would not financially work under any other funding source.
- 3. 9% housing credits allocated under the "Preservation" set-aside focus on HUD financed developments only. There are elderly developments which would benefit under this funding source in lieu of the EHCL program.
- 4. Rural developments meeting the older than 1990 age preference are not as favorably looked upon as it relates to funding available from local governments or public housing authorities.
- 5. Rural developments are mostly limited in the number of units per building and need a break in this area as well. It would potentially best suit Florida Housing's policy for these funds if there was a minimum number of units per development in lieu of units per building.
