I have a quick question regarding the selection process for RFA 2019-109.

Under the "Sorting Order", "County Award Tally" and "Selections Process" sections, it appears that Bay County can have a maximum of two (2) applications funded and all other counties can only have one (1) application funded.

Is that correct?

I wasn't sure if the language below was referring to the "Tier-1 category" itself or specifically to each county in the Tier-1.

Page 53:

"Tier 1 Applications may have more than one Application credited to the County Award Tally until all eligible Tier 1 Applications have been selected for funding."
