We have 2 comments:


- In Section 9b. of the draft RFA, Resident Community-Based Coordination an applicant is to provide (1) a chart showing evidence of owning and providing resident community-based service coordination on at least 2 PSH or permanent rental developments for homeless population. OR

 (2) the FHFC form Resident Community-Based Services Coordination Provide Certification form. Please provide a sample chart to eliminate any confusion on what the chart should include.
- 2. Goals the corporation has a goal to fund two applications that were awarded in the last pilot RFA. With the limited amount of funding, it is likely, a 3rd application will not be awarded which would defeat the intent of the RFA to award three projects. We request that the RFA limit the experience goal to one mandatory pilot RFA awardee, allowing other non-profits with experience to have a chance to compete.
